

DARKO DAVIDOVIĆ (Srbija)

Rođen je u Čupriji 31.07.1980. godine gde završava osnovnu muzičku školu "Dušan Skovran " u klasi nastavnika Ivana Ristića. Srednju muzičku školu "Kornelije Stanković" završava u klasi profesora Miloša Gerića.

Kao učenik osvaja prve i druge nagrade na Festivalima muzičkih škola Srbije i na Republičkim takmičenjima. Studije klarineta završava na Akademiji umetnosti u Novom Sadu u klasi profesora Mihajla Kelblija. Nakon toga upisuje studije saksofona, koje završava u klasi profesora Stojana Dimova.

Od 2003. godine radi kao profesor klarineta i saksofona u SMS "Petar Krančević" u Sremskoj Mitrovici, profesor saksofona u SMS "Isidor Bajić" u Novom Sadu, a od 2010 godine zaposlen je u OMS "Josip Slavenski " u Novom Sadu. Radio je kao asistent na predmetu kamerna muzika kod profesora Vasila Geleva na „Akademiji umetnosti“ u Novom Sadu.



Tokom školovanja bio je član duvačkog orkestra SMS "Kornelije Stanković", Simfonijskog orkestra "Akademije umetnosti", kao i brojnih kamernih sastava. Saradivao je sa orkestrom "Stanislav Binički" u Beogradu (klarinet), "Vojvođanskim simfoničarima" (alt saksofon) i sa orkestrom SNP-a u Novom Sadu (alt i tenor saksofon).

Bio je član žirija na Republičkom takmičenju 2007. godine za instrument saksofon, 2013 član žirija na Saksofonijadi u Smederevu.

Godine 2016. u Novom Sadu sa kolegama osniva udruženje "Muzički atelje" ,preko kojeg promovise mlade talente,organizuje koncerte i seminare eminentnih evropskih pedagoga i popularizuje izvođačku praksu klarineta i saksofona.

U dosadašnjem pedagoškom radu učenici klase Darka Davidovića osvajali su brojne nagrade na Republičkim takmičenjima, Festivalima muzičkih škola Srbije, Saksofonijadi u Smederevu, Međunarodnom takmičenju limenih duvača u Novom Sadu, Međunarodnom takmičenju drvenih duvača u Požarevcu,takmičenju Davorin Jenko u Beogradu .

DARKO DAVIDOVIĆ (Serbia)

He was born on 31.07.1980. in Cuprija, where he also graduated from the Elementary School of Music "Dusan Skovran", in the class of teacher Ivan Ristic. He graduated from the "Kornelije Stankovic" High School in the class of Professor Milos Geric.

As a student, he's won 1st and 2nd prizes at the Music School Festivals of Serbia and The National Competitions. He completed his Clarinet Studies at the Academy of Arts in Novi Sad in the class of Professor Mihajlo Kelbli, after which he started Saxophone Studies, and completed them in the class of Professor Stojan Dimov.

He had worked as a Professor of Clarinet and Saxophone at the "Petar Krancevic" Secondary School in Sremska Mitrovica since 2003, as well as a Professor of Saxophone at the "Isidor Bajić" Secondary School in Novi Sad, and since 2010 he has been an employee at the "Josip Slavenski" Elementary School in Novi Sad. He's worked as an Assistant Professor of Chamber Music under Professor Vasil Gelev at the Academy of Arts in Novi Sad.



In the course of his education, he was a member of the "Kornelije Stankovic" School " Brass Orchestra", the "Symphony Orchestra" of the Academy of Arts, and numerous chamber ensembles. He has collaborated with the "Stanislav Binicki" Orchestra in Belgrade (clarinet), the Vojvodina Symphony Orchestra (Alto Saxophone) and the SNP Orchestra in Novi Sad (Alto and Tenor Saxophone).

He was a member of the jury at the 2007 Republic Saxophone Instrument Competition, as well as a jury member at the `` Saksofonijada`` in Smederevo in 2013.

In 2016 in Novi Sad, he and his colleagues founded the association "Music Atelier", where he has been promoting young talents, organizing concerts and seminars for the eminent European pedagoes and popularizing the performing practice of Clarinets and Saxophones.

In their recent pedagogical work, students of the class of Darko Davidovic have won numerous awards at Republic competitions, Festivals of Music Schools of Serbia, "Saksofonijada" in Smederevo, International Competition of Brass Instruments in Novi Sad, International Competition of Woodwind Instruments in Pozarevac, and Davorin Jenko Competition in Belgrade.
