Jana Cheteleva Belevska rođena je u Bitolju, gde je započela svoje muzičko obrazovanje u klasi Margarite Tatarčeevske. Diplomirala je na Sofijskoj muzičkoj akademiji „Pančo Vladigerov“ u klasi Elene Dikove.

Magistrirala je sa punom stipendijom u Americi na Univerzitetu Južne Floride, u klasi Svetozara Ivanova, gde je radila kao asistentkinja na klaviru.

Dobitnik je brojnih nagrada na nacionalnim i međunarodnim takmičenjima:

Državno takmičenje - Skoplje, Petar Konjović - Beograd, Mladi virtuozi - Sofija, Interfest - Bitolj, Ohridski biseri - Ohrid, Klod Kan - Pariz.

Dve godine je pohađala letnju školu Mozarteum u Salzburgu gde je nastupala na koncertima i saradivala sa poznatim umetnicima Pavelom Gililovom i Achillesom Del Vignom.

Teteleva je saradivala sa vrhunskim umetnicima poput Tamare Podubnaja, Marčele Krudeli, Andreja Dijeva, Ahila Del Vigna, Pavela Gililova, Antona Dikova, Josipa Jermina, Renate Fišer, Rebeke Pinis, Džona O'Konara i drugih.

Sa 16 godina nastupila je sa Makedonskom filharmonijom, a 2008. godine je Muzička akademija izabrala za jedinog studenta koji je nastupio sa Sofijskom filharmonijom i izveo drugi koncert za klavir Sergeja Rahmanjinova.

Od 2009. do 2012. godine aktivno je učestvovala na koncertima širom Amerike, bila je deo serije Steinway & Sons Concerts, takođe je nastupala u Njujorku u čast čuvenog kompozitora Davida Del Tredicchia gde je izvodila svoja muzička dela.

Takođe je nastupala u brojnim kamernim ansamblima poput Predsedničkog trija Univerziteta na Floridi i klavirskog dua sa ruskom pijanistkinjom Azom Torškoevom.

Jana je nastupala širom Makedonije, Bugarske, Austrije, Nemačke, Francuske, Srbije i Sjedinjenih Država.

Trenutno radi kao profesor klavira u Državnoj muzičkoj školi gde su njeni učenici osvojili brojne nagrade.

Jana Cheteleva Belevska was born in Bitola, where she began her music education in the class of Margarita Tatarchevska. She graduated from the Sofia Music Academy "Pancho Vladigerov" in the class of Elena Dikova.

She completed her master's degree with a full scholarship in America at the University of South Florida, in the class of Svetozar Ivanov, where she worked as a piano assistant.

She has won numerous awards at national and international competitions:

State Competition - Skopje, Petar Konjovic - - Belgrade, Young Virtuosos - Sofia, Interfest - Bitola, Ohrid Pearls - Ohrid, Claude Kahn – Paris.

For two years she attended the Mozarteum summer music academy in Salzburg where she performed and collaborated with famous artists Pavel Gililov and Aquiles Delle Vigne.

Cheteleva has collaborated with top artists such as Tamara Podubnaya, Marchela Krudeli, Andrej Diev, Pavel Gililov, Anton Dikov, Josip Yermin, Renata Fischer, Rebecca Penneys, John O'Connor, Aquiles Delle Vigne and others.

At the age of 16 he performed with the Macedonian Philharmonic, and in 2008 she was selected by the entire music academy as the only student to perform with the Sofia Philharmonic and performed the second piano concerto by Sergei Rachmaninoff.

From 2009 to 2012 she actively participated in concerts across America, she was part of the series Steinway & Sons Concerts, also performed in New York in honor of the famous composer David Del Tredicchi where he performed his musical works.

She has also performed in a number of chamber ensembles such as the Presidential Trio of the University of Florida and a piano duo with Russian pianist Aza Torshkoeva.

Jana has performed throughout Macedonia, Bulgaria, Austria, Germany, France, Serbia and the United States.

She currently works as a piano teacher at the State Music School where her students have won numerous awards.
